Full-time: Complete the course in 1 year by taking the full-time option.

The course is open to students from a multidisciplinary and multiagency background.

The programme is skills-based and runs on a full time 1-year and part-time 2-3-year modular basis.

Teaching will be a blend of face-to-face teaching and e-learning and will include completion of a masters dissertation.

Modules will be delivered by leading authorities in the field of forensic mental health.
